

BSR Camp Guidelines:

Regional Camps, Camps involving D-C members, or camps held at facilities open to outside (ie. BSHP, Warfield)

- D- level traditional members required to stay on site with horses.
- C- level traditional members and above allowed to leave site with approval of RS or VRS (although staying is recommended)
 - o 1 C-level member can be responsible 2 horses.
 - o Members must write on stall card who “night sitter” is
 - o “Night sitters” must possess basic horse knowledge and be approved by RS or VRS if not a USPC member.
- Stall guards allowed at the discretion of RICs, RS, or VRS
- Horsemasters follow same guidelines as C-level members.
- Participants may be asked to stay on site if an emergency such as signs of colic or excessive stress arise.
- Safety for horse and rider, and compliance with USPC safety and suitable mount policies are a top priority at all times. (See attached suitable mount policy 0910)

Upper Level Camps, or camps at closed facilities such as White Aspen

- Members not required to stay on site. Stalls should follow proper rally procedure.
- Stall guards allowed overnight if owner or “night sitter” on site.
